Immersion Preschool		
No immersion curriculum for preschool age youth. No teachers available to teach the age group with advanced proficiency.	The Immersion Preschool is closed currently. The tribe is working toward Childcare licensing to achieve sustainable funding sources and ensure program stability. The tribe applied for a master apprentice grant to increase the number of teachers who can teach immersion.	We plan to reopen the immersion preschool in two to five years, when we can secure proficient teachers and add a second room to our childcare center.
Curriculum Development and Delivery		
No immersion instruction curriculum existed for pre-K through middle school. High school curriculum and college curriculum differed significantly. All curriculum focused on novice level speaking.	All age groups have improved immersion instruction curriculum and improved access to resources.	High school and college teachers are using the new curriculum as well as middle school outreach. Curriculum will be available on our website.
Community Classes		
No free community classes were being held.	During the grant we taught in person family classes. Beginner community classes are happening online twice a week.	Continue offering beginner classes online and encouraging participants to enroll in other programs as available.
